From Your Priests

Father Rice and I will be away this week attending the annual Fall FSSP Priest Convocation in Nebraska. I will return Friday, but Father Rice will stay in Nebraska through the weekend because he has been approved to make his first Temporary Incardination into the Priestly Fraternity of Saint Peter. Canon Law requires a five year period of discernment to go from one institute to another, and Father Rice now will begin his second year. At that same ceremony, Father van Zee and Father Bozant will both be permanently incardinated into the FSSP as they have both completed their five year discernment and have been approved. Father van Zee, currently our Pastor in Naples, Florida was assigned here 2019-2021 and Father Bozant, our Pastor in Baltimore, is known to many of you. Congratulations to all three priests!

As Father Rice announced last Sunday, we have been forced to temporarily suspend the Thursday period of Exposition. The construction noise is unavoidable because of the contract terms, and it has become just too noisy to have a reasonable period of Adoration. We know the importance of Eucharistic Adoration and will work to return it to the schedule as soon as the construction schedule allows. We will also look to see if there are any possibilities for temporarily rescheduling some Exposition in the evening hours when construction is not taking place. However, the extremely full parish schedule this year is making that a challenge. We will keep you posted.

Sacraments

The Traditional Latin Rites exclusively are offered at St. Stanislaus Parish

Baptisms - Parishioners, registered and active for at least four months, should call the office well ahead of the birth to arrange for the baptism of their newborn. A class with Father is necessary before the first Baptism in a family at the parish.

Holy Matrimony - Preparation for Marriage must begin at least 6 months prior to the desired date. Weddings are available for parishioners registered and active for six months before the beginning of Preparation for Marriage. Catholics must be married in the Catholic Church to have a valid marriage in the eyes of God and the Church.

First Confession, Confirmation & First Communion - Available for children of registered and active members of the parish. Preparation for these Sacraments for children will be announced in the bulletin. Adults who have not received these Sacraments are invited to call the office to arrange for special preparation by Father.
